# ABOUT THE VOLUNTARY ORGANISATION "PUNARBASA", KENDRAPARA

Aiming to empower and rehabilitate the most neglected & deprived differently abled community of the society along with giving them affordable Therapeutic services by skilled and trained Therapist, the Organisation PUNARBASA first constituted on dated 15th August 2009, on the guidance and vision of Dr. Biraja Routray (A Spinal Injured Quadriplegic Person). The voluntary organisation "PUNARBASA" was established with the objectives for awareness of rights and rehabilitation of physical & mentally challenged. It has been registered on 11th December 2009 under the Society Registration Act 1860 in the District of Kendrapara, the RPwD Act, 2016, Department of Social Security and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Govt. of Odisha Regd. No.- 312/ SSEPD of 2019, under Niti Aayog and National Trust Act, 1999. Since its formation, the organisation has been working relentlessly for the Rehabilitation, Empowerment, Upliftment, Therapeutic care, Welfare of disables, Grooming of Artistic Talents, Financial Assistance, Scholarship, Sponsorship Support to PwDs persons belonging to Kendrapara District. One regular physiotherapy and counselling centre is functioning under this organisation since October 2010, which is providing physiotherapy and other Rehabilitational services with minimum fees along with free counselling for rehabilitation in its physiotherapy and Rehab Centre which is also registered under Clinical Establishment Act, 2010.

Apart from that to create awareness of different disability Issues and Rights, our organisation is also conducting various Awareness activities including publication of first ever Bilingual Bimonthly Newspaper **THE PUNARBASA SAMACHAR** on various disabilities Issues for differently abled readers and for persons associated with rehabilitation also for creating awareness and enriching the knowledge by publishing information and research based articles on different types of disabilities.

Besides, publishing books and booklets on different types of disabilities for understanding of the common readers and having disabilities and also for creating awareness among citizens against the prevailing superstition and social stigma connected with disability in our society with this noble objectives and for the holistic rehabilitation of the differently abled of Kendrapara District.

As on today there are near about 300 different sign languages are being used by people having speech & auditory impairments around the world. A total 73 million people of the world are still deprived of their normal communication skills. In India near about 63 Lakhs people are speech and hearing impaired. As the sign language







plays a vital role to enable this section of people to communicate with rest of the world with the power of accessibility to education, economic affairs and all other requirements to sustain. Ironically out of the total auditory impaired population of India only 2 Percent are empowered or trained with this language, rest 98 percent are still in a state of incommunicative world.

To spread awareness about the importance of the day, the premier rehab organization of Kendrapara, PUNARBASA organised an Awareness cum Sensitization program in its therapy centre at Madhapur, Kendrapara.

Awareness and intervention are two tools through which the progress and severity of cerebral palsy can be checked. Around 17million people around world are suffering from cerebral palsy. This neuromuscular disorder impairs the new born from normal mobility.

In India due to lack of awareness and also scarcity of Rehabilitational Therapeutic Intervention the children having Cerebral Palsy mostly deprived from the possibilities of inclusion in the mainstream society. Starting from medicinal intervention to through multiple therapeutic interventional preventive steps the alarming growth of Cerebral palsy can be stopped. To spread awareness and the interventional role of therapy Punarbasa today on 6th September organised an awareness cum sensitization program on the eve of Cerebral Palsy Day.

In the first session two presentation on the topic -

- 1-"Cerebral palsy: dissecting the causes and prognosis " presented by physiotherapist Rachita Jena
- 2-"Rehabilitational challenges and therapeutic intervention" by Occupational Therapist Gunjansmita Behera.

The meeting was conducted by the Founder cum Advisor of the organization Dr. Biraja Routray. On this occasion District Child Welfare Committee Chairman Smt. As all know spinal cord injury disability is the most vulnerable type of disability out of the total 21 type of disabilities.



It also comes under the category of Locomotor disability. During this awareness Programme Doctor Birendra Ku Das, Senior surgery specialist of DHS Kendrapara, Doctor Monali MadhuSmita, Former asst Professor of Yoga and Naturopathy of North Odisha Medical college, Dr Biraja Routray Founder of PUNARBASA and physiotherapist Rachita Jena presented and discussed about the various ACI issues and its challenges. To extend a token of assistants, daily Urinary management kits for a period 6 months were distributed to all seven spinal cord injury survivors by the honourable guest of that Programme. Asst secretary Banshidhar Mohanty along with other support staffs of the origination helped in conducting this Programme.

Seven people with severe disabilities from Kendrapara district who suffer from severe disabilities such as spinal cord injury due to accident or fall from a height or due to any carelessness and serious diseases have revealed their tragic experiences on the occasion of World Spinal Cord Injury Awareness Day.

Which is enough to make others aware and alert even if it feels like a pain to others. Krishnananda Nayak of







Rajnagar Nirukana and Amiya Vishwawala of Chandanpur presented their brief life stories between being disabled from birth and moving through youth.

Halyanad Raut of Rajnagar West Bebra, Nirmal Dhal, Manas Ranjan Behera of Pattamundi Beltal, Parshuram Sahu of Nikrai, Amaresh Baral of Kor. On this occasion, each of them was given a surgical kit for daily urinary management for 6 months by Purnabas by the attending experts and guests.

### **Spinal Cord Injury Awareness Workshop by PUNARBASA**

Out of the total 21 types of disabilities, spinal cord injury people, who are counted under the category of mobility-impaired disabilities, live the most miserable lives.

Statistics show that only 50 percent of all spinal cord injuries and disabilities worldwide are caused by road accidents, and most of the rest are caused by falls from high places and other diseases

Once a spinal cord injury occurs, individuals with mild to severe disabilities face a post-injury life of social isolation, economic deprivation, and chronic health problems.

Such severe disabilities can be overcome to a large extent through awareness alone. For this purpose, a workshop was organized on the occasion of World Spinal Cord Injury Awareness Day on 5th September by Punarbasa, a voluntary organization working for the disabled.

Its founder and chief advisor Dr. Dr. Barendra Kumar Das, senior chiropractor specializing in the management of Birja Rautray, North

Dr. Monali Madhusmita, Assistant Professor of Praktan Naturopathy and Yoga, Odisha Medical College Physiotherapist Rachita Jena and Special Guest District Social Security Officer, Rupali Priyadarshani highlighted the physical, medical, yoga-centric treatment and social security aspects of spinal cord injuries.

On this occasion, people with spinal cord injuries from different parts of the district shared their experiences. Punarbasa provided each with a 6-month supply of equipment for their critical daily urinary management needs.


